- Arrival is at 7:35 AM
- Dismissal is at 2:35 PM
- We begin our day promptly at 7:35,
so please make sure to get your child here on time!
(Procedure for arrival and dismissal will be determined and communicated)



Information About CARES

- Before CARES is available starting at 6:30 AM
- After CARES is available from 2:30-6:00
- Forms for CARES are in your Wednesday Folder



Absences




- Call school when your child is absent
 - If you know the night before, you can leave a message
- A note **MUST** be sent in to school with the **REASON** and **DATE(s)** your child was absent
- If your child was vomiting or had a fever, they **CAN NOT** return to school until they are 24 hour fever and vomit free (without medicine to reduce fever)
- You are responsible to monitor your child's health each day before they come to school.

Example: Dear Miss McGlynn,

Jimmy was absent on October 18, 2020 due to a fever.

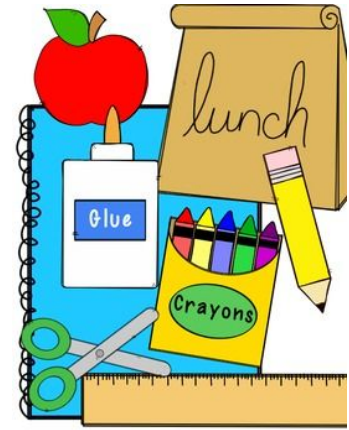

Uniforms

- St. Jerome Pre-K School Shirt
 - BLACK shorts or sweatpants
 - No buttons, snaps or zippers!!
 - SHORTS can not be worn after October 1
 - VELCRO shoes
 - No sandals, tie shoes or boots
 - Long sleeve shirts may be worn under school shirt in the colder months.
 - Please be mindful of the pants your child is coming to school in. Make sure they can pull them up and down themselves!
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Supplies

- School bag
 - One large enough to fit a standard folder and copy book
- Lunch box
- ALL crayons, folders, pencils, art supplies and rest time mats are provided
- Daily snack and drink are provided for our morning snack time
- LABEL EVERYTHING
- Activity Fee
- Please send in
 - 2 packs of baby wipes, not Wet Ones
 - 2 Clorox wipes
 - 2 boxes of tissues
 - Hand Sanitizer BOYS ONLY
 - 2 rolls of paper towels
 - 2 boxes of Tall Kitchen trash bags
 - Disinfectant Spray (aerosol) GIRLS ONLY



Other Materials

Headphones for computer class- Please place them in a ziploc bag with your child's name on it.

Lanyard- this could be used to carry your child's mask while they are not wearing it. - It is not mandatory but it might make it easier to not lose them.

Please put clear contact paper on your child's Take Home Folders and Wednesday Folder

Personal Hygiene

- Children must be completely toilet trained and are responsible for their own bathroom care
- Children **MUST HAVE** a change of weather appropriate clothing that must be labeled, in ziploc bags and in their school bag at all times
 - This is used in case of an accident, spill, etc



Masking Wearing and Social Distancing

Masks **MUST** be worn in the hallway at all times. (bathroom, playground etc.)

Masks will be required in the classroom as much as your child can with multiple breaks to take them off especially during snack and lunch.

Hand Washing and hand sanitizing will be scheduled throughout the day.

Your child will have an assigned desk to sit at with their own items stored.



More Information

Students will still have their specials :Gym, Music, Library, and Computers.
Teachers will come to the classroom, rather than our class coming to them.

Please continue practicing proper hand washing and sanitizing practices with your child at home.

Bring in 4 spare masks stored in a labeled plastic bag with your child's name on it.



Cleaning Precautions

We will clean daily:

Desks (multiple times)

Toys that were played with

Carpet spots

Art tools/other materials

Each child will have their own materials to use: crayons, glue, etc.

and not to be shared



Lunchtime Procedures

- Lunches can not be heated up
- Please be conscious of what you are sending in with your child
 - NO FAST FOOD lunches can be sent in or dropped off
 - No lunchables
 - No large water bottles, gatorade bottles etc
- A small dish towel must be sent in with your child. It will be used as a placemat for lunchtime.
- Leftover food will be sent home, so you will know what your child did not eat.
- Following playtime, students will rest for about 30 minutes.



Communication

Take Home Folder- classroom/home :This is sent home every night and must be sent back the following day

Left side- look over, leave home

Right side- read, return, respond

Wednesday Folder- St. Jerome/home

This is sent home every Wednesday and must be returned Thursday
